- 9 helicopters, 32 advanced life support and critical care ambulances

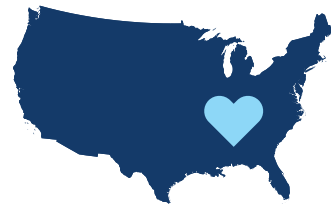


One of the nation's busiest critical care centers
