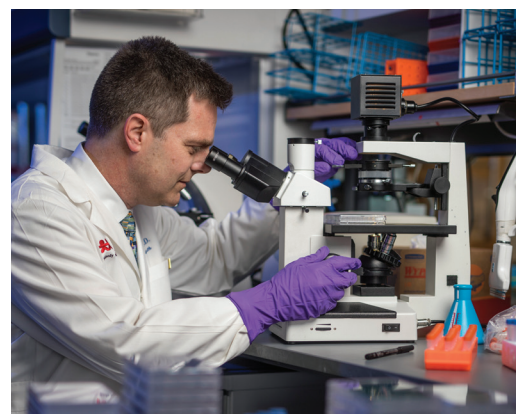


## Make a Gift That Pays You Income for Life

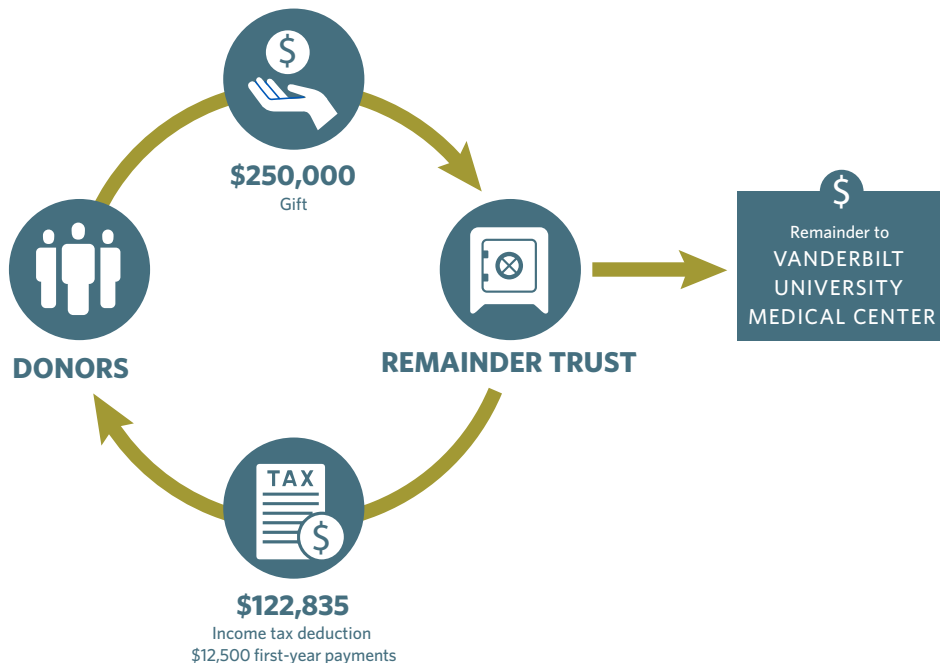
### JOIN THE LEGACY CIRCLE
